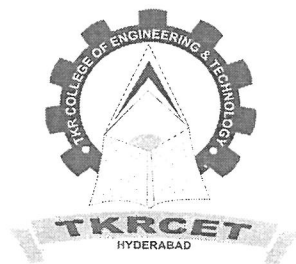

The approved Academic Calendar was circulated to all departments and students.

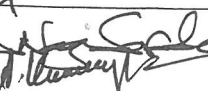
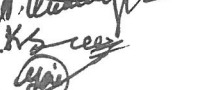

Agenda Item :: Implementation of JNTUH Grace Marks Policy for TKRCET R22 Regulations

The Academic Council meeting of our institution was held on 06-06-2026. Subsequently, JNTUH issued proceedings No : AA/DAP/JNTUH/R22 Grace Marks/1005/2026 dated 30-06-2026 regarding the award of Grace Marks for students admitted under the R22 Academic Regulations. Since the proceedings were issued after the Academic Council meeting, the matter could not be placed before the Council.

Accordingly, the approval of the Academic Council is sought for implementing the following JNTUH guidelines:

1. Extension of the Grace Marks policy to all UG and PG programmes offered under the TKRCET R22 Academic Regulations.
2. Award of Grace Marks up to 0.15% of the total maximum marks of all semesters in the programme, as per the JNTUH guidelines.
3. Eligibility for Grace Marks shall be limited to students who:
 - o have completed all four years of study;
 - o have appeared for all Semester End Examinations; and
 - o have passed all courses except one, two, or three courses, where the award of grace marks enables them to earn the required credits for the award of the Provisional Degree Certificate.
4. Any revisions, amendments, or further guidelines issued by JNTUH from time to time regarding the award of Grace Marks for R22 Regulations may be implemented by TKRCET for the students admitted under the R22 Regulations, in accordance with the University directions.

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
